



**ARTICLE 4**

**AMEND ZONING BYLAW –  
MEDICAL MARIJUANA TREATMENT CENTERS**

To see if the Town will amend Chapter 135 of the Code of the Town of Lexington, the Zoning Bylaw, by including a definition of and instituting a temporary moratorium on the use of land or structures for a Medical Marijuana Treatment Center, said moratorium to expire no later than July 31, 2014, or act in any other manner in relation thereto.

*(Inserted by the Board of Selectmen)*

DESCRIPTION: This article will impose a temporary moratorium on locating Medical Marijuana Treatment Centers (MMTCs) in the town. The recently adopted regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Health implementing Chapter 369 of the Acts of 2012, “An Act for the Humanitarian Medical Use of Marijuana” allow for “local oversight and regulations, including fee requirements,” but do not allow a town to prohibit MMTCs. The moratorium will provide a defined period of time for the town to develop regulations for MMTCs.

And you are directed to serve this warrant not less than fourteen days at least before the time of said meeting, as provided in the Bylaws of the Town.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, on or before the time of said meeting.

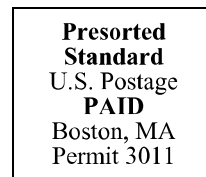
