## TMMA Annual Meeting

March 12, 2024

The TMMA annual meeting was held in person at Lexington High School, Science Lecture Hall.

After the annual meeting, each of the nine precincts met separately to elect their three Precinct Officers (Chair, Vice-Chair, and Clerk) for this year.

Bridger McGaw (TMMA Chair) called the annual meeting to order at 6:32 PM.

#### 1) Chair's Report—Bridger McGaw presented the following to the TMMA membership:

Bridger announced the agenda and order of tonight's meeting. He thanked current Officers for serving and reflected on this past year, highlighting our work on enhancing information sharing to better prepare TM members for Town Meeting. Initiatives of note this year include:

- a. Continued work to streamline the process and promptness of when and how materials are made available to TM members. This included providing feedback to the Town on Annual and Special Town Meetings in 2023, suggestions to enhance the town's Town Meeting website, and delivery of a memo to the Select Board on information sharing.
- b. Increased email updates to TM members with links to materials and meetings to foster and encourage information gathering earlier in the process.
- c. Organized the return of the Black Cat Café for 2023.
- d. Reviewed our by-laws and will continue a subgroup discussion of possible updates for 2024.
- e. Continued focus on DEI training and awareness for TM members.
- f. Documented critical work processes and created a new Shared Drive for TMMA. This effort will continue in 2024 and beyond.
- g. Hosted another successful TMMA Connect! event (Ice Cream Social).

### 2) Approval of 2023 TMMA Annual Meeting Minutes—Bridger McGaw

Brielle Meade distributed the minutes for last year's meeting for review via email prior to this meeting. It was moved and seconded to accept the Minutes from last year's annual TMMA Meeting as presented. The Minutes were unanimously approved.

#### 3) 2023-2024 Treasurer's Report—Noah Michelson

Noah distributed the Treasurer's Report via email prior to this meeting. He presented the following report:

a. The TMMA remains financially stable, and the end of year balance is \$3,222.72.

- b. Expenses were limited to: bus tour for Annual Town Meeting (ATM) 2023; Black Cat Café supplies; Town Staff Thank You "cake and coffee hour"; and administrative expenses (new checks and web hosting). Upcoming planned expenses not in this report include the TMMA Connect! ice cream social event and the bus tour for ATM 2024.
- c. Revenue was received from voluntary dues and donations. 79 percent of members paid their dues in 2023. A new payment option, Venmo, was introduced for this year and proved to be popular (22 percent of all dues collected coming through the platform). Cash continued to be the most common form of dues payment. Dues will remain at \$10.00 for 2024.
- d. \$592 in donations were received this year, entirely from patrons of the Black Cat Café. These donations helped offset the total cost of running the café.
- e. Noah explained the four options for paying voluntary dues (cash, check, Venmo @Noah-Michelson, and PayPal @NoahMichelson) for this year. He distributed envelopes to each Precinct Clerk for collection of cash and will also send out an email with details on how to pay electronically.

It was moved and seconded to accept the Treasurer's Report and the report was unanimously approved.

### 4) Nominating Committee TMMA Elections – Andy Friedlich

Andy Friedlich and the Nominating Committee (Scott Burson, Jim Osten) announced the slate of candidates for TMMA officers. He noted that the Chair, Vice-Chair and Treasurer shall not serve in the same office for more than two consecutive terms. None of the current officers have reached their term limit, and all agreed to return in their current positions if elected. Having asked the members, no alternate names were proposed from the floor. A motion to elect the slate of candidates was moved and seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The TMMA Officers elected for 2024-2025 are:
